SEVENTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST



The Massabki brothers: Francis, Abdel Moati, & Raphael

(Maronite martyrs, who offered up their lives a burning offering of love to Christ in Damascus in the year 1860). Francis, Abdel Moati and Rafael were brothers, who lived in Damascus, Syria, in a devout Maronite family, known for its piety, wealth, nobility, and compassion towards the poor and the needy.

In the year 1860, when the Muslims in Damascus and the Druze in Mount and South Lebanon attacked and massacred the Christians, our martyrs, along with a large crowd of Christians, took refuge in the Franciscan monastery in Damascus, after the Muslims had set the fire in

the Christian neighbourhood. In the monastery, they were praying and celebrating the mysteries of Reconciliation (confession) and Eucharist for the last time.

While Francis stayed alone in the Church, kneeling down before the statue of Our Lady of Sorrow and praying, he was filled with hope. After midnight a band of armed Muslim rioters broke into the Christians monastery. were terrified and confused, some managed to run away, and others hid themselves. The rioters shouted: "where is Francis Massabki? We are after him". At that, Francis approached them audaciously, saying: "I am Francis Massabki, how can I help you?" They told him, that we have come to save you and your family, under one condition, that you become Muslims, or we will kill you all. He answered them: "We are Christians and faithful to Christ we live and die. We do not fear those who can kill the body, as the Lord Jesus said."

Then, he looked at his brothers and said to them: "have courage and stand firm in your faith, because the crown of victory is already ready in heaven for those who persevere till the end." At that, his two brothers confessed publicly their faith in the Lord Jesus saying: "We are Christians, and we want to live and die as Christians." Thus, their

persecutors attacked them, beating them with their sticks, knives and axes. In this manner they were killed, preferring death over denying their faith in Christ, who crowned them as martyrs. That happened in July 10th in the year 1860. His holiness Pope Pius XI had declared them blessed in October 10th, 1926, thanks to the efforts of bishop Bechara Al'Shemali, the Maronite Archbishop of Damascus. May their prayers be with us. Amen.

ملخص العظة

زمن العنصرة: إرسال التلاميذ الإثني عشر هذه الفقرة من الإنجيل تتحدث عن الرسل الإثني عشر الذين أرسلهم يسوع ليبشروا العالم. مهمة التلاميذ مشابهة تمامًا لمهمة يسوع. إذهبوا واشفوا المرضى، وقولوا لهم المكوت الله قد اقترب".

أوصاهم يسوع أن يكون سفر هم خفيف. ماذا يعنى هذا؟ هل يطبّق هذا في الوقت الحاضر؟ كم من أشياء عديمة الجدوي نجد في منازلنا؟ كم من ثقل نحمل في حياتنا؟ قلق وضغط وخُوف. لكُلّ منّا حمَّله، وأحيانًا ما تتشابه أحمالنا مع أشخاص آخرين. عندما نسمح لأنفسنا أن نستسلم للقلق والخوف، ننسى أن يسوع هو القائد. عندما نسمح للغضب أن يسيطر علينا، ننسى صانع السلام. أحيانًا تكون مشاعرنا مرتبكة، لكن هذا لا يعنى أنه يجب أن تقبى كذلك. الله يريد أن يكون هو من يقيم في داخلنا، وإذا سمحنا لتلك الأمور أخرى أن تستقر فينا، لن يبقى ليسوع مكانًا ليعمل فينا. فهل تساءلتم يومًا ما معنى "مساكين في الروح"؟ انها تتحدث عن عدم وجود حِمْل داخلي أو هوية مرتبطة بالأمور المادية والدنيوية المعارضة لتعاليم الله؛ حينئذ فقط بكون ملكوت الله قربب.

نبّه يسوع التلاميذ ألا يعلنوا رسالتهم الخاصة وألا يضعوا برنامجهم الخاص، ألا ينشروا أفكار هم الخاصة وألا يطالبوا بأي شيء؛ بل أن تكون رسالتهم رسالة سلام. أوصاهم ألا يمييزوا ويختاروا بين الناس بل أن يبشروا عن سبل الله.

"إنّ الحصاد كثير" هذا الأمر صحيح، أنه نفسه في اليوم الحاضر كما كان في زمن يسوع. الحضور في الكنيسة قليل، ر و خصوصًا من الجيل الشّاب. إحدى ظواهر الإيمان الحالية أن الناس باتت تبتكر عقائدها الخاصة. نسمعهم يقولون: أنا أؤمن بالله ولكنى لستُ ملتزم دينيًا؛ لا أذكر آخر مرّة ذهبت بها إلى الكنيسة لكن أنا إنسان صالح لا أسيء للآخرين أطبق الوصايا العشرة!!!!! ممممم أليست إحدى الوصايا تنص بوضوح "قدّس يُوم الربّ"؟ يذكرني هذا بقصة الكاهن الذي كان يحيّي أبناء الرعية بعد قداس الأحد ور أي شخصًا كان غائبًا لفترة طويلة، فأخذه جانبًا وسأله "سيّدي، هل تريد أن تنضمّ إلى جيش الربّ؟"، أجابه الرجل "أنا منتم من قبل إلى جيش الربّ"، فسأله الكاهن "كيف ذلك ولا أراك سوى خلال عبديّ المبلاد والفصيح؟" همس الرجل في أذن الكاهن "لأننى من شعبة المخابرات".

أنذر يسوع تلاميذه من مقاومة ورفض الناس لهم، هذا ما يحدث اليوم، لم يتغيّر شيء. الكثير من المسيحيين يُتهضون اليوم بسبب إيمانهم أكثر من أي وقت مضى.

أوصى يسوع تلاميذه بالأمور التي يجب أن يغطوها ولكنه لم يحدد لهم كيف يقاس نجاحهم. قال لهم: إن لم يقبل الناس رسالتكم، أنفضوا الغبار عن أرجلكم وامضوا في طريقكم. في مهنتنا وحياتنا اليومية من الصعب تجنب قياس نجاحاتنا. نعيش في زمن الإنتماء وتحديد الدرجات ووضع الميزانيات والمحاضر وكل ما يحدد مراتب الأشخاص. هذه الأمور تسهل علينا قياس النجاح، فيستند عليها البعض لتحديد رعايتنا. هذا الأمر يتعارض مع رسالة يسوع في إنجيل اليوم. علينا أن نتكل على تقييم يسوع لنا ونأمل أن يقول لنا "هنيئًا لك أيها العبد الصالح الأمين".

يقول يسوع للتلاميذ الإثني وسبعون "إذْهَبُوا. هَا إِنِّي أَرْسِلُكُم كَالْحُمْلانِ بَيْنَ الدِّنَابِ". يريدهم أن يثقوا بالله ويريدنا أن نقوم بالمثل. أرسلهم في طرق خطيرة وأرادهم أن يتكلوا على حماية ومعونة الله فقال لهم "لا تَحْمِلُوا كِيسًا، وَلا زَادًا، وَلا جِذَاءً، وَلا تُسَلِّمُوا عَلَى الطَّريق".

الرسالة لا تزال مستمر اليوم، حيث يرسال يسوع رجالاً ونساء، اثنين اثنين، ولكن الفعلة قليلون. فلنصلي من أجل المزيد من الفعلة لخدمة الله الذي هو وحده مخلصنا من خلال ابنه الوحيد يسوع المسيح. آمين

Dear Parishioners of OLOP:

We pray that you are healthy and staying safe in these trying times. God willing this will end as soon as possible and we can all safely assemble together again.

As you may know, for the last few months, we have been preparing to demolish the house on Pleasant Street. We have finally obtained all the permits, passed all the necessary inspections and have disconnected all the utilities. We are now able to knock the building down. The cost of demolition has been quoted at between \$10,000 and \$15,000 and we have hired a company to begin in the next week or so. This year has been a difficult year for our church. We were unable to have our annual Hafli and now our summer festival has been postponed, and we may have to cancel it. For years we have relied on our fundraisers to help pay our monthly bills. Without them our savings get depleted.

While we consider ourselves a wealthy parish when it comes to our parishioners, you are all aware that we are not as monetarily wealthy as we would like. We have money in both our building fund and our general fund but to withdraw the amount needed for the demolition will certainly leave us in a weakened position. We understand that this is also a very difficult time for all of our parishioners, but we, as OLOP's Financial Council and an advisory board for Fr. Vincent, have an obligation to ask if you could find some donations to help offset the cost of the demolition.

Any amount you can donate will help us maintain our savings for emergencies.


