



Students have met, befriended, and served disadvantaged people, AIDS victims, the homeless, farmworker families, and the elderly in the nearby town of Immokalee, and as far away as New York, Chicago, Mexico, Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, Haiti, and Calcutta.

No other college in the U.S. has a closer connection to Mother Teresa than Ave Maria University. Our President, Jim Towey, served as Mother Teresa's legal counsel for the last 12 years of her life, and volunteered for her full-time for two years, helping open an AIDS home and a mission in Mexico. President Towey also served as Director of the White House Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiatives for President George W. Bush.

With permission from the Missionaries of Charity, the order that Mother Teresa founded, the Mother Teresa Project at Ave Maria University was established in 2013.
