

EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

As we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, let us take a moment and reflect what this symbol, this universal Catholic symbol, means to us and to our Church. As we reflect I am sure there are many thoughts that go through our minds. There are many images associated to the cross of Jesus Christ and today is a reminder for us to think about this in a deeper and more meaningful way. We may think about the passion of Jesus Christ when we see the cross. We may wear a cross around our necks to protect us from evil. We may use the cross as a way to bless others. But the most important image we should take from the cross is that of victory; victory of Jesus conquering the evil one and his misleading ways--- victory for our salvation. The cross means VICTORY, and

that is how we should view this symbol as we commemorate the Exaltation of the Cross. We thank Jesus for taking this cup into his hands and to embrace his pain and suffering for the salvation of our souls and for the forgiveness of our sins. This is the symbol of the cross that we must be grateful for and that we must celebrate everyday of our lives.

IN OUR PRAYERS OUR LADY OF PURGATORY MARHAJAN


