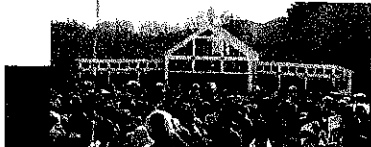
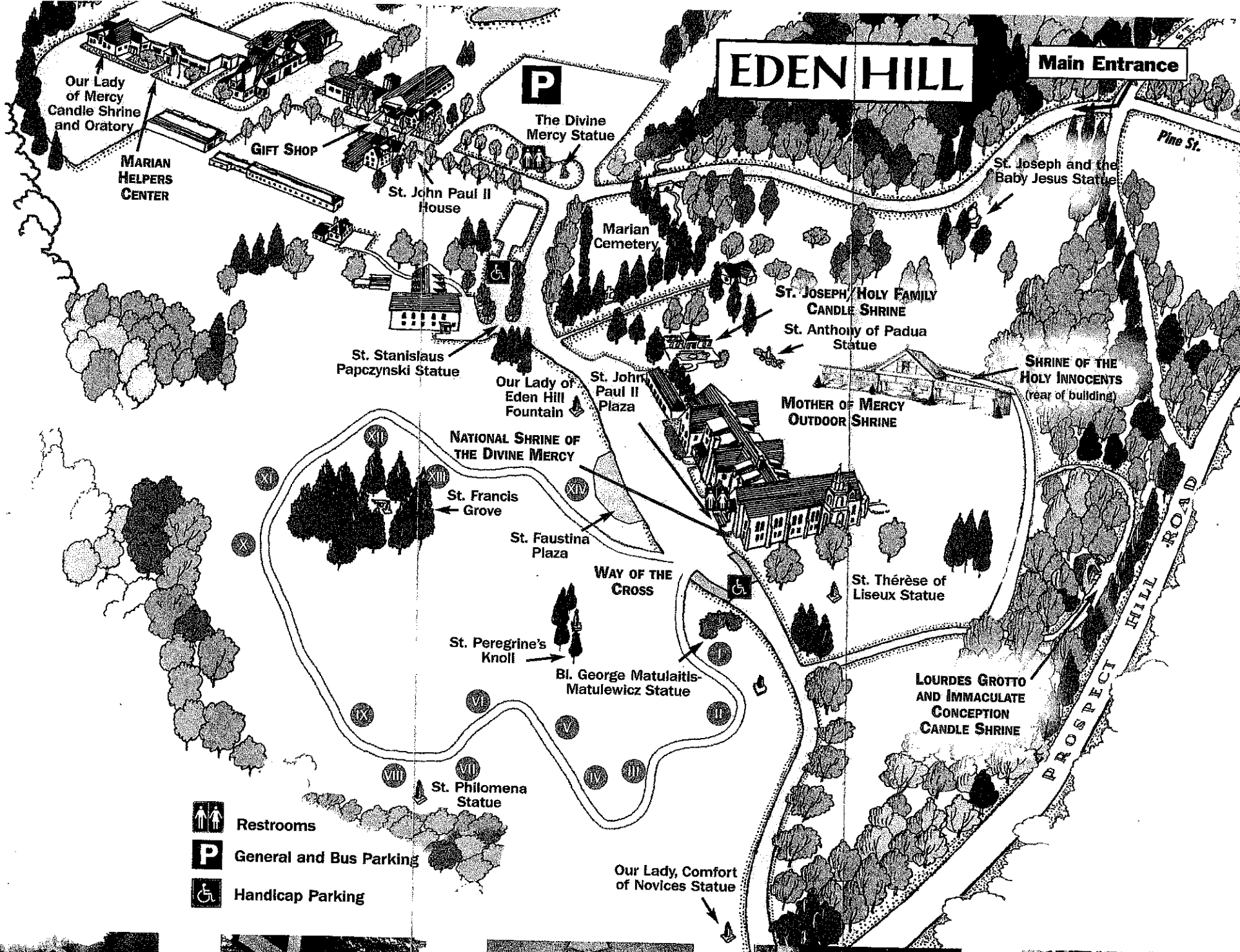


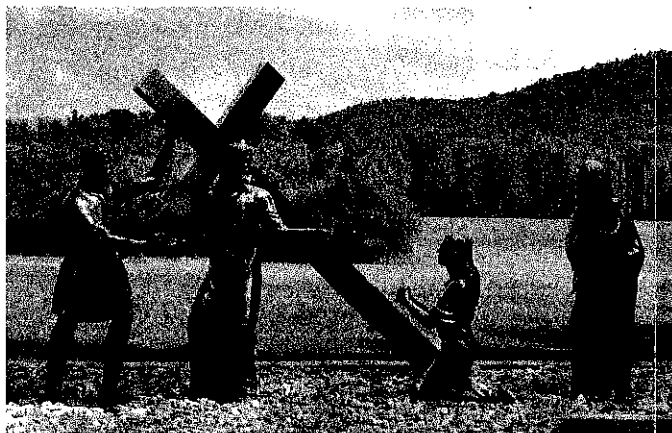

Group Pilgrimages

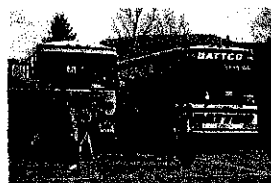
"Pilgrimage is a joyous community experience that leads one before the Lord, to seek His face, to experience the joy of His house." (Saint John Paul II)

All bus pilgrimages require prior approval before registering online or sending in a paper registration in order to make certain there is not a large event already scheduled or the day is filled. Please email our pilgrimage coordinator with your request at pilgrims@marian.org.

If you are visiting the National Shrine by private car, there is no need to register. However, if there are more than 10 people in your group coming by car, we ask that you call the Shrine receptionist ahead of time and let her know. She can be reached at 413-298-3931.

We do have limited space in the Shrine, so please contact the Shrine receptionist ahead of time to find out if the afternoon schedule (including Mass) will be held outside rain or shine. Please plan and dress accordingly.

During your pilgrimage, there are many places to pause for prayer and meditation. These include the Way of the Cross, the Lourdes Grotto and Immaculate Conception Candle Shrine, Shrine of the Holy Innocents, Mother of Mercy Outdoor Shrine, and the St. Joseph/Holy Family Candle Shrine. The St. John Paul II House

The St. John Paul II House on Eden Hill offers clean, basic, but comfortable, accommodations giving pilgrims an opportunity for spiritual renewal. The name of each room bears significance to Eden Hill: the St. Peregrine Room; the St. Faustina Room; the St. John Paul II Room; the Blessed Mother Room; the St. Therese Room; the St. Francis of Assisi Room, and the Divine Mercy Great Room.



Although meals are not provided, a shared kitchen may be used by pilgrims who bring their own food for their stay. The house also offers a shared library/sitting room.

Rooms are booked through the Shrine receptionist. During certain times of the year, reservations fill up quickly. A suggested offering can be discussed when reserving your stay. Call 413-298-3931 or email shrine@marian.org to make your reservation.



Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, a Rosary for Life, Confession, and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy are available every day at the Shrine. Outdoor candle shrines, gardens, fountains, the Way of the Cross, and Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto, all encourage prayerful contemplation.

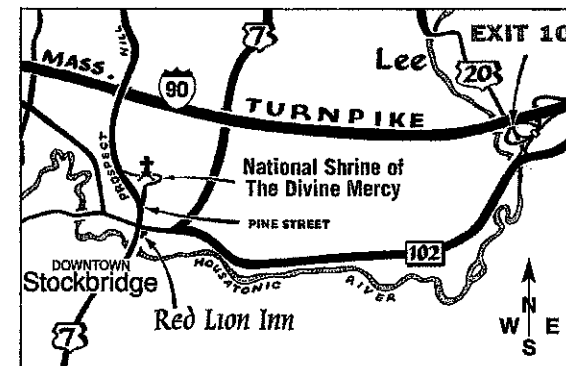
