

WELCOME TO THE DEDICATION OF OUR LADY OF PURGATORY CHURCH

The Feast of the Immaculate Conception will always be a special day in the life of Our Lady of Purgatory Church. This is because on December 8, 1918, Bishop Daniel F. Feehan, the Bishop of the Diocese of Fall River dedicated the original Our Lady of Purgatory Church. Now, 105 years later to the date, the Most. Reverend Gregory John Mansour, Bishop of the Eparchy of St. Maron of Brooklyn, will dedicate our new church to Our Lady of Purgatory.

Our recent journey here has been a bittersweet journey. All the parishioners hold very special memories on Franklin Street, but most believe in their heart that this was the best opportunity for our Church to grow and to continue the great legacy of their ancestors who had a vision to begin a Maronite Community in New Bedford, Massachusetts, over 100 years ago.

It is with this faith that we now begin another chapter in the life of OLOP. This comes during the time of the Birth of our Lord Jesus Christ. His birth brings to us His great love, peace, joy, and hope. I know that He will always surround us with his love and continue to guide us with His Holy Spirit because he told us that He will never abandon us, no matter where we are. The Holy Trinity has led the way for this new journey of faith and the Holy Trinity will continue to lead us as we embark on our next chapter.

I welcome Bishop Gregory Mansour, who has set aside this day to consecrate our new home. We thank him for his guidance, support, and belief in this humble community. I also thank my brother priests from the Maronite Church, the Melkite Church, and the Latin Church from near and far. Your presence and support have been an anchor for me and this community.






