



# PROJECTS FOR THE NEAR FUTURE

In an effort to keep everyone up to date regarding plans for the OLOP, I would like to mention some items that will need our attention before summer approaches. As you know, we are still fundraising for the Capital Campaign to pay the balance of \$200,000.00 to the Fall River Diocese. This amount is due to them by the end of June 2025. We are also raising towards the \$5,000.00 matching grant that was given to us by the Anthony Abraham Foundation which is due by September 1, 2025.

We need to fix our main parking lot of the Church. Originally, we were getting quotes to replace the parking lot, however, this has proven to be more costly than what we can handle at the present time. I will be getting quotes about filling the holes and sealing the larger portion of the parking lot so that it will be safe for everyone to walk on.

Lastly, we are finishing the beautification of the Church and Parish Hall with plants and perennials, along with quotes for a lawn sprinkler system. It is my hope that by the time the festival comes in September, everything can be completed. Once I receive the quotes needed, I will publish them in the bulletin.

I truly thank all of you who have contributed to our Capital Campaign thus far. Because of you we have been able to achieve where we are right now. This has been a blessing for our parish. We are almost there brothers and sisters. Through our hard work, prayers, and God's graces, we are closer to our goal in securing the future of this beautiful community. 
# CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR 2025 EDUCATION FOUNDATION RECIPIENTS
