CONTINUING CHURCH PROJECTS

In addition to our Capital Campaign to pay off the Diocese of Fall River, our Church grounds need two projects. The first is the paving of our parking lot. At this time, we are not in a financial position to have this area blacktopped in the way I would like. However, I have received that would include quotes jack hammering the old tar and disposing it, applying gravel, followed by an application of 4" Macadam. This is a composite of crushed stone to create a durable surface. It would be rolled out and made smooth. This project would encompass all the way up to the sidewalk entrance of the church parking lot. Later, when funds are available, we can then have the entire parking lot black topped and restriped. This project is estimated to cost \$18,000.00 and is my first priority as this is more of a safety issue than anything else.

The second project is to install the lawn sprinkler system. I have also received estimates on this project which range between \$18,000.00 to \$21,000.00. It is my hope that our Church grounds can be as beautiful as possible and something that makes each of us proud.

Once I can raise the funds for one or both projects, we will begin the work on them. It is my hope that we can accomplish this before the summer festival.
