ELEVENTH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

August 15 – Solemnity of the Assumption The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is one of the most beautiful and hope-filled celebrations in our Catholic faith. On this solemnity, we honor the moment when Mary, at the end of her earthly life, was taken body and soul into heaven. The Church teaches that this singular privilege was granted to her because of her unique role in salvation history as the Mother of God, her sinless life, and her perfect union with the will of God.

Mary's Assumption is not just about her—it is also about us. Her being assumed into heaven is a sign of what awaits all the faithful. She is the first among us to fully share in the resurrection promised by Christ. Where she has gone, we hope to follow. In her, we see our future glory made present. Her Assumption is not merely a personal triumph, but a triumph for all humanity, a victory of grace over death.

This feast is deeply scriptural in spirit, even if the event is not explicitly described in the Bible. It is a dogma of the Catholic Church, defined by Pope Pius XII in 1950, based on tradition and theological reasoning, with scriptural passages cited as supporting evidence. The roots of the Assumption lie in passages like Revelation 12, where the woman clothed with the sun appears in glory, and in the deep reverence the early Church had for Mary. She who bore Christ in her womb, who remained faithful at the foot of the cross, who was present at Pentecost with the Apostles, would not be left to corruption in the grave. The Assumption is the natural and

divine consequence of her immaculate life and perfect discipleship.

For us today, Mary's Assumption challenges us to reflect on how we live in light of eternity. Do we live as people of hope? Do we seek holiness in our daily lives? Mary teaches us that a life lived in humility, service, and faithfulness to God will never go unrewarded. Her "yes" to God opened the way to salvation for all of us, and her eternal glory shows what awaits those who say "yes" to God every day.

One way for us to say yes is to pray the Rosary daily. **The Church's Endorsement** –

The Rosary developed over centuries, beginning in the Middle Ages, and was promoted strongly by saints like **St. Dominic** (early 13th century), who according to tradition received the Rosary from Mary in a vision to help fight heresy and lead souls to Christ. Later popes officially endorsed the Rosary as a powerful prayer for the faithful.

Mary's Own Requests in Apparitions – In several approved apparitions, the Blessed Virgin Mary personally asked us to pray the Rosary. The most famous examples are:

Fatima, Portugal (1917) — Mary appeared to three shepherd children and said: "Pray the Rosary every day, in order to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war."

Lourdes, France (1858) – While she didn't give long instructions about the Rosary, Mary appeared holding one and prayed it with St. Bernadette.

Other apparitions (like Akita, Japan; Medjugorje) also repeat this call to daily Rosary prayer.

The Reason for the Request- Mary's request is not because the Rosary is "for

her" in the sense of worship but because it is a Christ-centered prayer that meditates on the life of Jesus through her eyes. Mary always leads us to her Son, and she knows the Rosary is a powerful spiritual weapon for conversion, peace, and protection.

Let us look on Mary not as a distant figure, but as a loving mother and guide who walks with us. Let us entrust our struggles, our prayers, and our hopes to her intercession. And may we live with our eyes fixed on heaven, longing not for earthly crowns, but for the eternal joy of being with God, as Mary is now.

"Mary, assumed into heaven, pray for us."


