THIRTEEN SUNDAY OF PENTECOST

HOW CAN WE LOVE JESUS THE WAY HE LOVED US? "AS I HAVE LOVED YOU" (John 13:34)

Jesus's love is the most powerful reality in all of Scripture. It is not a distant or vague affection—it is personal, sacrificial, and unconditional. His love is seen not only in His words but most deeply in His actions: reaching out to the marginalized, forgiving sinners, washing the feet of His disciples, and above all, laying down His life on the Cross.

Saint Paul reminds us that "while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). Jesus didn't wait for us to be perfect. He came into our brokenness and loved us fully. This is **agape** love that gives everything without asking for anything in return.

But Jesus does not stop there. He gives us a command: "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 13:34). It is not merely a suggestion; it is our Christian identity. We are called to love with the same mercy, patience, and humility He shows us.

Loving like Jesus is not always easy—but we are not alone. The Holy Spirit, given to us in baptism, enables us to live this love daily. Whether in our homes, communities, or even among strangers, every act of service, forgiveness, and compassion reflects Christ's love at work within us.

This week, take time to dwell in His love—through prayer, Scripture, and the Eucharist—and ask the Lord: "Teach me to love as You love."

Every sincere follower of Christ eventually faces: "How can I love like Jesus if I'm sinful, weak, and often fail?" The answer lies not in our strength, but in God's grace working

within us. We Cannot Love Like Jesus on Our Own for Scripture is clear: "Apart from Me, you can do **nothing."** — John 15:5 On our own, we are limited. We are wounded by sin, prone to selfishness, quick to judge, and slow to forgive. But that's precisely why we need **Jesus**. He never asked us to do this alone. **Jesus First Loves Us, Then Transforms** Us: "We love because He first loved us." — 1 John 4:19 Before we can love like Jesus, we must receive His love. He doesn't wait for us to be perfect; He meets us in our weakness. When we allow His love into our hearts—through prayer, the sacraments. and the Word-He heals, cleanses, and changes us. It's not about becoming strong on our own. It's about surrendering so that His strength can work through our weakness. "Mv grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." -2Corinthians 12:9

The Holy Spirit Makes It Possible "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." — Romans 5:5


At baptism and confirmation, we receive the Holy Spirit—the very love of God. This Spirit gives us: The power to forgive when we've been deeply hurt, the patience to endure suffering, The compassion to serve others without pride, The courage to love enemies and stand for truth. Loving like Jesus is supernatural, but the Spirit equips us with supernatural help.

Love Grows in Small, Daily Choices We love like Jesus not just in grand gestures, but in daily sacrifices: Holding our tongue when tempted to lash out, listening patiently to someone difficult, helping someone who can't repay us, praying for

someone who has wronged us, and love grows when we allow Jesus to shape our hearts in **ordinary moments**.

Even When We Fail, His Mercy Lifts Us We will fall short. Often. But Jesus doesn't give up on us. He calls us to repent and gives us new grace each day. "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end. They are new every morning." - Lamentations 3:22-23 Each failure is not the end—it's a chance to begin again, with Him.

In Summary: How can we love like Jesus, though we are weak and sinful? We can't—unless: We receive His love first, we rely on the Holy Spirit, we walk daily in humility, we allow His mercy to pick us up repeatedly for Jesus doesn't call the perfect. He perfects the ones He calls, and He is patient with us as we learn to love like Him.


