THE BEAUTY OF WAITING FOR THE LORD IN THE EUCHARIST

Waiting is not something we usually enjoy. In our world today, everything is instant. Food, communication, entertainment. We click and it happens. Yet, when it comes to the things of God, waiting is not wasted time. It is holy time.

Think of the Psalmist who cries out: "I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word, I hope" (Psalm 130:5). Waiting prepares the heart, stretches our desire, and enlarges our capacity to receive.

Every time we wait for Mass, whether the daily Eucharist or the Sunday celebration, we are simply not passing time until something begins. We are like the wise virgins in Jesus' parable (Matthew 25), with lamps lit, hearts awake, longing for the bridegroom to arrive. The Eucharist is that wedding feast, and our waiting is the oil of our lamps.

WHY DO WE STRUGGLE WITH ONE HOUR AT MASS?

Here's something to ponder. Why is it that many of us, including myself, can spend hours at a restaurant with friends, enjoying food and conversation without watching the clock? Why do people spend an entire evening at a concert or a party, sometimes four or five hours straight, and never complain it's too long?

And think about this: people will even camp outside a store all night to be first in line for the newest phone or video game. They'll wait in the cold, on the sidewalk, because they believe what they're waiting for is worth it. Yet, when it comes to Mass when it comes to Christ Himself, present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, one hour feels too long.

The difference is not in the clock but in the heart. We wait joyfully for things we love. We make time for what excites us. If our eyes of faith were open, we would realize that the Mass is the greatest banquet, the truest celebration, the deepest encounter. Heaven and earth meet

THE EUCHARIST AS FULFILLMENT OF OUR WAITING

Each Mass is a meeting with Christ. But it is more than that — it is a foretaste of heaven. Every Sunday, especially, we join in the eternal liturgy where heaven and earth meet. Our waiting throughout the week builds a holy hunger, so that when Sunday arrives, we come not out of routine but out of longing.

Waiting teaches us that God's presence is not controlled by our schedule. Rather, it is an encounter of love that requires patience, humility, and readiness. Like a bride awaiting her groom, the Church waits for Christ at every Mass, and one day, at the end of time, we will wait no more for we shall see Him face to face.

TAKEAWAY

So, my dear brothers and sisters, let us rediscover the beauty of waiting for Mass. When we arrive early, when we prepare our hearts during the week, when we pause in silence before the liturgy begins, these moments are not wasted. They are like the old man's minutes in the church: time spent waiting for a Friend.

May our waiting make us more attentive, more grateful, and more in love with the One who comes to feed us with His very Body and Blood. And may our longing for Sunday Mass remind us that we are pilgrims waiting for the eternal banquet in heaven.






