Dear Parishioners of OLOP:

Last week I made an announcement that we would be doing a face lift in our Church Hall. Below you will see a rendition for our hall. The work that will be done will consist of painting, flooring, window treatments, lighting, and interior doors near the classrooms.

We will be doing the painting ourselves with the help of anyone who is willing. We have already received donations for seven of the eight chandeliers at the cost of \$600.00 each. The flooring will cost \$27,000.00 as shown in the drawing below. We have decided not to go with carpeting. The window treatments will cost \$5,000.00.

By doing this work, we will have the opportunity to begin renting this space which will help the church throughout the year with our expenses. It will also give

us a beautiful space to host our many functions.

To accomplish this, we need donations for the flooring and window treatments. If you would like to donate to this project, I would greatly appreciate this. Once we have most of the money needed, we can then begin this project.




