



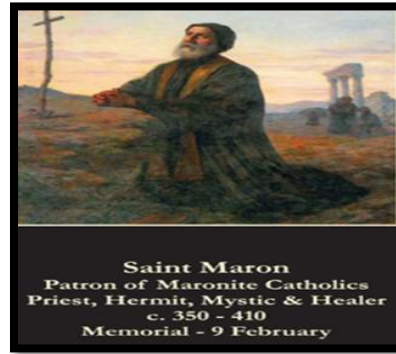
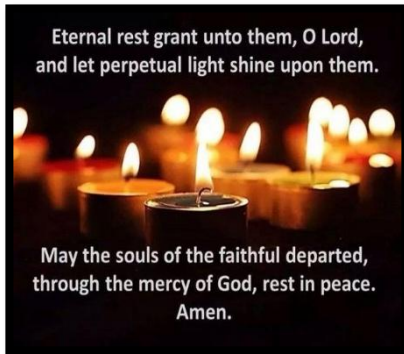

SUNDAY OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED FEAST OF SAINT MARON



Before the Maronite Church leads us into the Great Fast, she once again invites us to pause. Not to rush. Not to prepare lists of sacrifices. But to remember with hope. We remember the faithful departed our parents and grandparents, spouses and children, friends and neighbors, those who walked with us in faith and now rest in the mercy of God.

We pray for our faithful departed because love does not end at death. In the Maronite tradition, death is not a wall, it is a passage. The Church teaches us that those who have died in Christ are still part of us. To pray for the departed is to say: "You are still my mother. You are still my father. You are still my loved one." Our prayers do not disturb their rest. They complete our love. They Shaped Who We Are. The faithful departed are not strangers to us. They are written into our lives. They taught us how to pray. They carried us to church. They passed down faith through quiet example. They stood by us in moments of joy and suffering. Many of them were not famous. Most were never publicly recognized. Yet they lived holiness in ordinary ways.

The Church remembers them because faith is inherited before it is chosen. Why Remember Them Before Lent?

Because Lent is a journey of the heart. Before we examine our sins, the Church invites us to examine our roots. We remember those who: forgave us when we failed, loved us when we were difficult, taught us perseverance through hardship. Their lives become a mirror, asking us: "How will your faith be remembered?"

At every Qorbono, we pray: "Remember, O Lord, the faithful departed..." This is not symbolic language. It is a declaration of faith. Those we love are not absent. They are present in a new way. Our prayers lift them, and their lives continue to shape us.

There is a reason why certain names still bring tears. Why certain voices echo in our memory. Why certain graves still feel close.

To remember the faithful departed is not weakness. It is faith. What This Commemoration Teaches Us: It teaches us: that death does not have the final word, that mercy is stronger than judgment that memory is sacred, it teaches us that the Church is bigger than what we see. So, we should "Live well. Forgive freely. Don't judge. Pray often. Trust God completely." Their lives invite us to walk Lent not with fear, but with

hope.

As we remember the faithful departed, we place them gently into God's mercy, the same mercy we will one day need. May their memory be eternal. May their souls rest in peace, and may their faith guide us as we enter the Great Fast with humility, repentance, and hope.

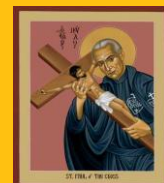

ASH MONDAY SERVICES



As we approach the Season of Lent, this is a friendly reminder that Ash Monday services will be held on Monday, February 16, 2026. There will be two Liturgies that day. The first one will be held at 11:00 AM and the second will be held at 7:00 PM.

OBSERVANCE

The Most Reverend Bishops Gregory Mansour and Elias Zaidan have issued the following Lenten guidelines for the Maronites of the U.S.:

. All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Lent.

. Ash Monday and Great Friday of the Crucifixion are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.

Personal Devotion

Clergy, religious, and laity who wish to observe the more traditional Maronite practice of fasting and abstinence are encouraged to do so. That practice is summarized in the following, taken from the Synod of Mt. Lebanon (1736):

Every weekday of Lent (Monday through Friday) is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat and dairy products (eggs, butter, milk, etc.) Fasting involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon.

The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat or dairy products. Dairy products are excluded because they are animal products. Saturdays and Sundays are exempt from fasting and abstaining as are the following feast days: The 40 Martyrs- March 9, St. Joseph- March 19, and the Annunciation- March 25.

FISH FRY FRIDAYS

Fish Fry Fridays are here once again. We will begin Friday Lenten Dinners on Friday, February 20, beginning at 5:00 PM and ending at 8:00 PM. Fish Fry Fridays will be held every Friday during Lent. 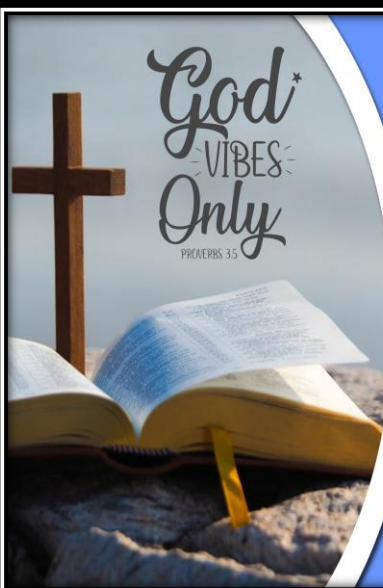
